Dear Mrs. Aggarwal:

I am pleased to inform you that the Accrediting Commission for Schools of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges has granted Madhu Bhasha Kendra Learning Center initial accreditation during the WASC Winter Commission meeting. The term of initial accreditation will run through June 30, 2013. This term of initial accreditation specifically covers the following categories:

High School Subjects: Hindi I, Hindi II, Hindi III

Tutorial Programs: Hindi I, Hindi II, Hindi III

Prior to the end of this period, Supplementary Education Programs must complete a self-study assessment and submit a written self-study report, including progress made in addressing the initial recommendations. The emphasis of the self-study should be the evaluation of the effectiveness of the program and its operations to support high achievement of all students based on the WASC criteria. The resulting action plan should reflect a synthesis of the identified growth areas and serve as a guide for ongoing improvement. Your organization will receive information and materials needed for the self-study process during the school year prior to the full visit.

Subsequently, the Supplementary Education Program will be visited by a WASC Visiting Committee to evaluate the organization's programs and operations and the impact on student learning. The team will review the organization's self-study findings and review supporting evidence, conduct classroom observations, and dialogue with all stakeholders. As a result of this visit, the Visiting Committee will recommend a term of accreditation to the WASC Commission. The WASC Commission will then grant or deny accreditation.

The approval of initial accreditation entitles you to use the following phrase on transcripts or in advertising: "Supplementary Education Program: Fully Accredited by (or) Accredited by the Schools Commission of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges," until such time as your accreditation has either lapsed or been denied.

Transcripts of students may be stamped or embossed with the WASC accredited seal which can be obtained from the WASC office, or the phrase noted above "Supplementary Education Program: Accredited by ..." phrase can be typed on the transcript.

If you choose to disclose your accreditation status in any communications with the public, you must specify the program(s) and/or course(s) covered by the accreditation status.
