

2011 Hindi Immersion Summer Program with MBK Language Center

General Information & Registration Form

Madhu Bhasha Kendra aka MBK Language Center, a 501(c)(3) non-profit educational organization is proud to announce its 3rd Hindi Immersion Summer Program in Palo Alto.

2011 Hindi Program will run from June 27th through August 14th, and is appropriate for students entering 1st through 7th grade in Fall 2011.

Location - 870 N. California Avenue, Palo Alto (Stratford School)

We are looking for students who are interested in learning Hindi, and parents who are willing to make the commitment to support what it takes to learn a new language.

*Preference will be given to students enrolling for all 7 weeks. Consistent attendance, ontime drop off and pickup is required. Students will be evaluated regularly and progress will be recorded. All classes are taught by qualified teachers to make learning fun and exciting.

Fee: \$350/wk (\$210 for week of July 4th)

Lunch & Extended Day - \$100/wk (\$60 for week of July 4th)

April Special - 10% Discount for campers enrolling for 3-5 weeks. 20% discount for campers enrolling for 6-7 weeks.

Refunds: We require a written request for any cancellations. In general we have a no refund policy unless a class is cancelled or other valid concern.

Day Activities (9:00am - 3:00pm)

Scheduled activities for Hindi language, Indian Dance and Hindi Music start at 9:00am and go through 3:00pm with a lunch break and other short stretch breaks in between.

Extended Day activities from 3pm to 6pm (optional) entail introduction to Indian mythology, Naatak and fun Art activities, and is managed by our expert High School students who are fluent in Hindi. Food served is fresh and vegetarian. Please indicate any dietary restriction in comment section of the registration form.

Students' work will be displayed at the site. Student work might be kept by MBK and used as samples for future programs.

Some Student activities might be video taped. Parents must provide in writing if they have any objections to this. A copy of this video will be available for parents to view and purchase.

Please submit a completed Registration Forms along with your check. Prior knowledge of Hindi language, dance or music is not required. Information provided by parents will help us group students appropriately, where they can enjoy learning, without getting frustrated. Students will be grouped according to teacher evaluation in specific areas.
